Expedition & Outdoor Leadership

Looking to develop your company/battalion's outdoor programme? We have lined up the following dates for the entry-level expedition and outdoor leadership training.

(Venues will be decided based on demand and location of the trainees.)

BASIC - Theory

Date: 29th January, 19th February, 26th February 2019 (3 nights/2.5hrs per night) or Date: 11th February 2019 – (1 day/7.5 hrs)

BASIC – Practical hike and camp – Two days

Date: The two weekends and locations to be confirmed. Likely to be in May 2019

The **BASIC** course is aimed at those that are new to E&OL and interested in getting young people outdoors. On gaining the BASIC certificate the leader will be equipped to teach and lead accompanied training expeditions in moderate and familiar terrain and in doing so, gain experience. The leaders must complete the theory and practical elements to gain the BASIC certificate.
