



Compass Badge Challenge

The Compass Badge Challenge will be held in **Shawlands Trinity Church**, 5 Moss Side Road, Glasgow, G41 3TP on **Friday 21 February 2020**.

Participation in the challenge is limited to younger Boys in their first year of membership of the Company Section, with teams comprising two or three Boys. There is no limit on the number of teams from any Company.

The Challenge will comprise three sections: Bible Knowledge, Drill and BB Knowledge.

Boys should wear uniform.

1. Bible Knowledge

The Bible Knowledge component will comprise a series of questions based on the passages below which focus attention on events associated with Easter from the Gospel of Luke.

Luke 23 v 1 – Luke 24 v 12

In preparation for this, teams should familiarise themselves with the passages.

2. Drill

The drill component will comprise practical drill. The movements are given overleaf.

3. BB Knowledge

This will comprise a series of questions based on the Boys' Brigade past and present, see overleaf for more information on topics covered.

When submitting the Entry Form please specify your Company's preferred report time; it is expected that teams will take approximately 30 minutes to complete the Challenge. Every effort will be made to accommodate Companies although it may not be possible to offer every team their preferred time.

Drill

The Squad of three Boys will be fallen-in in single rank at the position of attention.

The movements are then as follows.

Squad, Stand at – EASE
Squad, Atten – TION
Turn to the right, Right – TURN
Turn about, About – TURN
Turn to the right, Right – TURN
Incline to the left, Left in – CLINE
Salute to the front, to the front, Sal – UTE
Incline to the right, Right in – CLINE
Squad will advance, by the right, Slow – MARCH
Squad – HALT
Turn to the right, Right – TURN
Squad, Quick – MARCH
Change direction right, Right – WHEEL
Move to the right, Right – TURN. By the left.
Move to the left, Left – TURN
Change direction left, Left – WHEEL
Squad, Mark – TIME
Squad – HALT
Turn to the left, Left – TURN
Dressing, Right - DRESS
Stand at – EASE
