
In the world today there are many more rich countries such as our own but even more poorer ones.


Organisations like Christian Aid and Oxfam help bring aid to poorer countries so that their people ca live decent lives.




Attached to your booklet are pictures to colour in showing how people in poorer countries live and work. There is also a map of the world showing where foods are produced.
