## **PRESIDENT'S BADGE REGULATIONS**

Awarded to members who show all round proficiency within the programme, having completed the following:-

### **METHOD A** ("Get the Credit" requirements)

- 1 Be at least 15 years of age or be in the session in which he becomes 15.
- 2 Have at least 2 years' regular service.
- 3 Hold Grade 3 in all activity group badges and in Brigade Leadership.
- 4 Be recommended as suitable by the Company Captain

### **METHOD B** ("Get the Credit" requirements)

- 1 Be at least 15 years of age.
- 2 Have been a member of the Company for at least 1 session with good behaviour and attendance:
- 3 Attend a Christian Faith class or Bible class and take an active part.
- 4 Attend a Grade 3 leadership course or equivalent.
- 5 Obtain the Duke of Edinburgh Bronze Award, gained within or outside The Boys' Brigade.
- 6 Be recommended as suitable by the Company Captain.

### **METHOD C** ("Discover" programme requirements – from August 2007)

- 1 Awarded during year 4
- 2 Complete a Christian faith development course
- 3 Have good attendance for 1 session
- 4 Be recommended by the Company Captain
- 5 Participate in a non-residential teamwork skills experience run by Battalion, District or Region.
- 6 Completed at least 30 topics from the Discover programme, having gained three badges in the last 12 months
- 7 Taken part in an activity based residential event within the BB
- 8 Complete 10 hours of practical service for the Brigade or church

### **METHOD D** ("Discover" programme requirements – from August 2007)

- 1 Awarded during year 4
- 2 Complete a Christian faith development course
- 3 Have good attendance for 1 session
- 4 Be recommended by the Company Captain
- 5 Participate in a non-residential teamwork skills experience run by Battalion, District or Region.
- 6 Gained Bronze Duke of Edinburgh's Award
