The Kilbryde Hike is for young people in small teams. Organised by Boys' Brigade Officers, it is open to entries from all youth organisations, groups and schools. Teams can be all boys, girls or a mixed group.

The Hike begins at around 8am on the Saturday Morning, concluding with a meal and prize-giving at the finish on the Sunday Afternoon. Young people taking part must be suitably prepared, proficient in map reading and physically fit enough to cover the distances outlined across varying countryside terrains. Teams are required to be self-sufficient and carry all equipment necessary for their safety. A kit list is issued in advance of the Hike.

Teams are given grid references to navigate themselves from checkpoint to checkpoint around the hike course, with set time limits. At each checkpoint teams will face either a physical or mental challenge for additional points. On the Saturday night everyone will camp at a designated campsite. A campsite will be available on the Friday night before the hike for teams if required.





The 2019 Hike has five different categories within it, providing a challenge at a suitable level for all, whether new to outdoor pursuits and hiking or experienced at hiking with excellent navigation skills.

### **Senior Hike**

For teams of three - five young people all aged from 14-18 years old on the day of the hike. Senior teams will cover around 25 miles over the weekend. The cost is £12.50 per person.

### **Junior Hike**

For teams of three - five young people all aged 14 years old or younger on the day of the hike. At least one member of the team must be 14 years old. Junior teams will cover around 25 miles over the weekend. The cost is £12.50 per person.

### **Veteran Hike**

For teams of three - five people of any age. Veteran teams will cover around 25 miles over the weekend. The cost is £15.00 per person. This category is ideal for people who have taken part in the hike over the last 50 years to come back and join us again.





**Expedition Hike** For young people aged 11 years or older on the day of the hike, accompanied by an experienced adult or Senior. At least one member of the team must be aged 13 years old or younger. Maximum of 6 per team. Expedition teams will cover around 18 miles over the weekend. Teams have a reduced kit list, with larger items being transported for them. The cost is £12.50 per person.

**Explorer Hike** A one day hike option for young people aged 11 years or older on the day of the hike accompanied by an experienced adult or Senior. Maximum of 6 per team. This is designed for those who are new to hiking. This category will only do the Sunday of the hike, with the option of camping out on the Saturday night. Teams will cover around 10 miles, there is a reduced kit list. The cost is £10 per person.
