#### Safer Recruitment & Good Governance

The new processes introduced in May where Company Captains, in the majority of circumstances, use the PVG ID Checking Form to submit the information required by BB Headquarters to process an online PVG application for a volunteer appear to be working well. Company Captains should be aware that the PVG Checking process at Brigade UK will only start when the LREG1a form is received.

When the LREG1a form is received, prospective new Leaders will be added to OBM with a Pending status against their Role. Once all the necessary PVG checks are complete and the prospective Leader completes the mandatory E-Learning Modules the Role description will change to either Lieutenant, Warrant Officer, Helper, Residential Activity Helper or Staff-Sergeant and they will be availabe, if approved by the local Kirk Session to start work in the section.

#### **Church of Scotland Data Cleanse Project**

Your church's Safeguarding Coordinator will have received information about a data cleanse project initiated by the Church of Scotland. The purpose of this project is to ensure that local congregational Safeguarding Registers (SG7) are completely up to date.

To help your Safeguarding Coordinator prepare, it would be beneficial to provide them with an updated list of all Boys' Brigade Leaders currently listed in Online Brigade Manager (OBM). It is important they know which individuals are actively involved in regulated work, as new legislation prohibits keeping individuals on the congregational register unless they are currently engaged in such work. The law now forbids retaining names on the register "just in case" they might help again in the future.

Proactively addressing this will not only assist their efforts but also enhance your relationship with the congregation.

#### **E-Learning**

The Board of Trustees monitor the uptake of the mandatory Brigade UK E-Learning Modules as part of good governance processes. Thanks are due to the 379 fully registered Leaders involved in weekly programmes who have completed this exercise. We are at 99.5% compliance which is a great improvement from the 70% figure last year.
